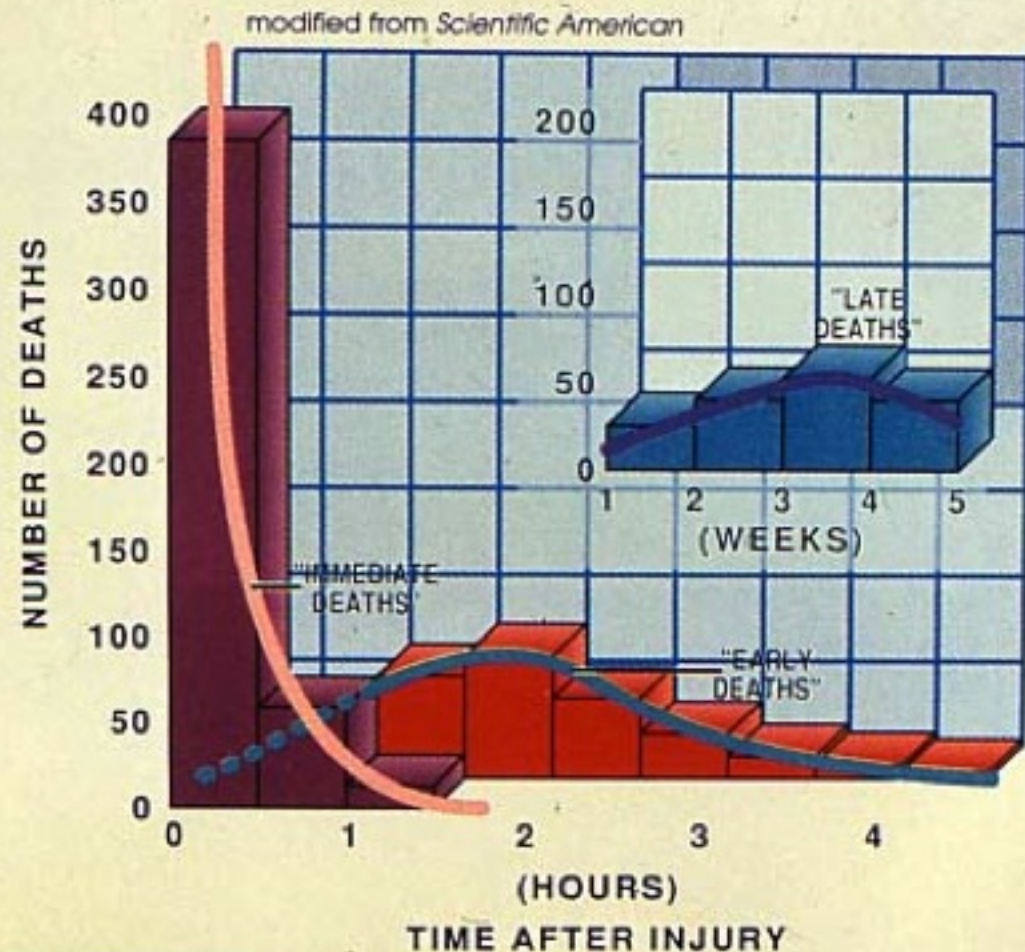

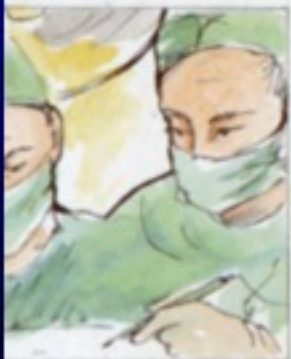

- Teamwork

What is Teamwork?

- **More than a collection of individuals working together**

- **“Team” is ultimately responsible for patient outcomes**

TRAUMA RESUSCITATION Vertical vs. Horizontal

- **Vertical - ATLS model**
 - ♦ **Limited personnel**
 - ♦ **ABCDE sequentially**
